All disaster training is free of charge and open to anyone interested in the Red Cross disaster relief service.

Online Courses

Basic Food Safety Course (Prerequisite for Emergency Response Vehicle Driver Course) – self-paced and approx. 1 hour #FHMCC200S

Disaster Services: An Overview – Module 1 (Prerequisite for all disaster training) - self-paced and approx. 1.5 hours #DIS000095

Will provide information about ways you can help your community prevent, prepare for and respond to emergencies and disasters.

Red Cross ReadyRN

Self-paced and consists of 20 individual modules. Each module takes approx. 1 hour (RN's, LPN's, EMT's and CNA's)

The curriculum will provide Health Services Disaster workers with the knowledge and skills to respond in a timely, safe and appropriate manner to various types of disasters including catastrophic events and public health emergencies.

Instructor-led courses:

Public Affairs: An Overview

Saturday, November 5, 2011 – 10:00 am to 1:00 pm – Manhattan office

This course will give you an overview of public affairs and skills to relate to media while out on a response. This will include some hand-on experience and mock interview opportunities.

Disaster Action Team Workshop/ Disaster Services: An Overview- Module 2

This course will introduce you to our disaster action team procedures and responsibilities. This course's focus is to educate you on helping families in northeast Kansas recover from the most common disaster – fires.

Friday, November 18, 2011 – 9:00 am to 4:00 pm – Topeka office

This course is designed for Mass Care workers who will serve as supervisors or managers on a multi-chapter or national disaster relief operation.
