Eric Voth, MD, FACP is a specialist in Internal Medicine, pain management, and Addiction Medicine as well as a medical director at Stormont-Vail HealthCare in Topeka, KS. He is the chairman of the Institute on Global Drug Policy, is recognized as an international authority on drug use, and lectures on drug policy-related issues, pain management, and appropriate prescribing practices. Dr Voth previously served as the former medical director of St. Francis Chemical Dependence Services. He also serves as an advisor on alcohol and drug abuse issues to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, is a former member of the National Advisory Committee for the Center for Substance Abuse Treatment of HHS, and is a Clinical Associate Professor of Internal Medicine at the University of Kansas School of Medicine. Dr. Voth has advised Reagan, Clinton, both Bush administrations, and has advised or testified for numerous Congressional offices on drug related issues. He has appeared on or consulted to numerous other television and radio media, and has been quoted by numerous international print media.

Timothy M. Scanlan, MD, MBA currently holds several professional positions in Wichita, Kansas to include a Private Practice in Addiction Medicine, a Medical Director with Addiction Specialist of Kansas, Inc. a Medical Director with Lifeline Stop Smoking Clinic, and a Medical Director with Central Kansas Foundation. Dr. Scanlan obtained his MBA from Wichita State University and his MD at University of Minnesota. Some of his academic appointments are as an Interim Program Director, Via Christi Family Practice Residency in Wichita, Kansas, a Clinical Professor with Department of Family and Community Medicine, and with University of Kansas School of Medicine – Wichita, Kansas. Dr. Scanlan currently is affiliated with Medical Society of Sedgwick County and has been since 1978. He serves on the Board of Advisors for DUI Victim Center and Board of Advisors for Addiction Counseling Program, Butler County Community College. Dr. Scanlan has publications to include: "Substance Abuse Among Older Adults, TIP 26", "Detoxification and Substance Abuse Treatment, TIP 45", and "Essential Family Medicine". Dr. Scanlan was awarded the Kansas Exemplary Teacher Award, KAFP, on 6/14/02 and the Pi Alpha, National Honor Society for Physician Assistants on 4/13/06.
